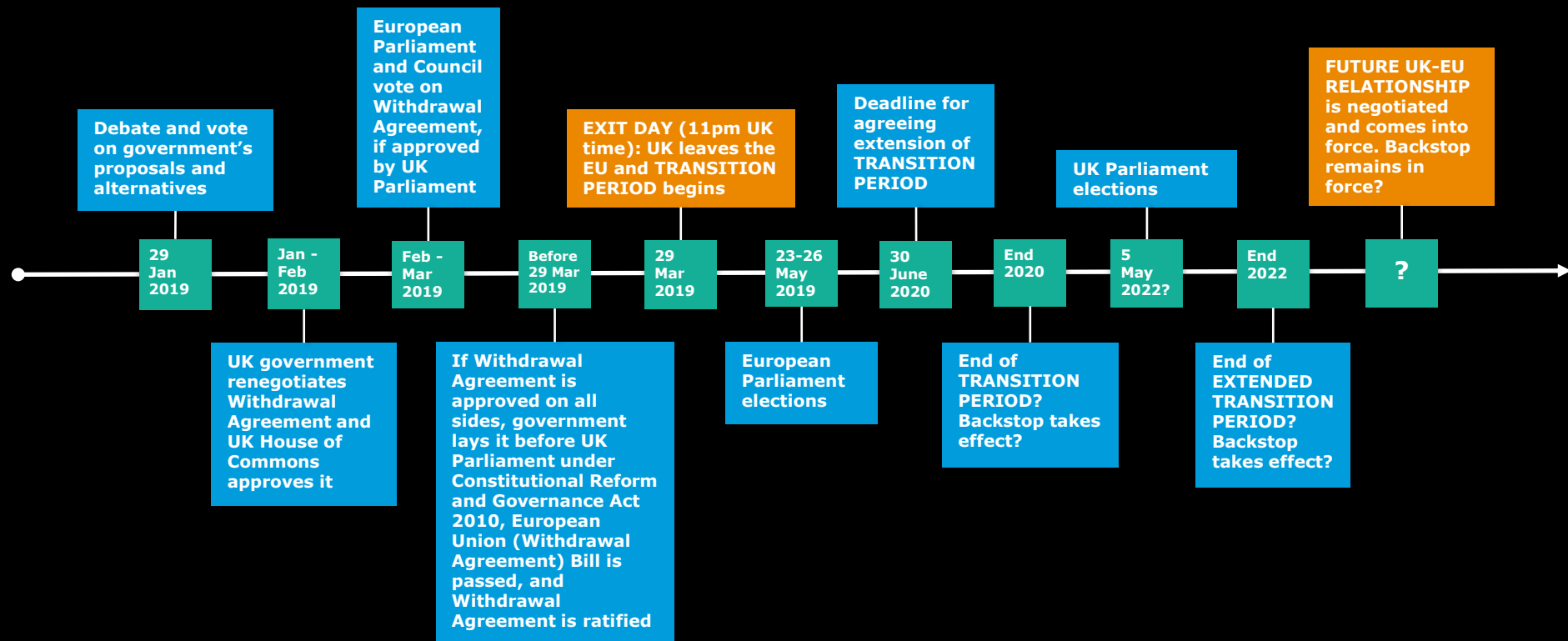


Brexit timeline

The timeline below shows how Brexit is meant to unfold from the UK government's point of view. In practice Exit Day (currently 29 March 2019 at 11pm UK time) could be postponed, and Brexit might even be cancelled - see our chart, The Way Forward, for different scenarios. Where reference is made here to 'Withdrawal Agreement', this should be taken as including the Political Declaration on future UK-EU relations that accompanies it. The Withdrawal Agreement proper is intended to be binding, the Political Declaration not.
