


Brexit timeline

The timeline below shows how Brexit is meant to unfold from the UK government's point of view. In practice Exit Day (currently scheduled for 29 March 2019 at 11pm UK time) is likely to be postponed, and Brexit may be cancelled altogether - see our chart, The Way Forward, for different scenarios. The government's room for manoeuvre is severely restricted by the timetable of events surrounding the election of a new European Parliament in May - see boxes in green, below. Where reference is made here to 'Withdrawal Agreement', this should be taken as including the Political Declaration on future UK-EU relations that accompanies it. The Withdrawal Agreement proper is intended to be binding, the Political Declaration not.
